Camping forms will be online April 15. Some camping rules & financing have been redone. Camping packets receive a pass to the fair. Cars will not be parked at camp sites. Cars can still be parked inside the gate. There will be a combined parade of entries for all fair participants. Special recognition will be given to last year members & state qualifiers. The person that does the kitchen at fair may want to do open show kitchen. Horse camp applications

are available April 1. \$200 for campers, \$85 for Jr Leaders. \$20 for camping per night. Campers must leave Friday morning. June 16-21 (Sun to Fri). It is open to multiple counties. Any donations, including food, would be appreciated.
